

EXCERPT FROM THE MINUTES OF 4th QUARTER VIRTUAL REGIONAL STATISTICAL COMMITTEE-1 (RSC-1) MEETING HELD ON 12 DECEMBER 2022 AT THE CITY OF FERNANDO, LA UNION

RSC Resolution No. 11 series of 2022

ENJOINING ALL REGIONAL LINE AGENCIES, LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS
AND THE PRIVATE SECTOR IN REGION 1 TO SUPPORT and PROVIDE DATA NEEDED
FOR THE COMPILATION OF THE 2022 PROVINCIAL PRODUCT ACCOUNTS (PPA) OF
THE PROVINCES OF REGION 1

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA), established through Republic Act No. 10625, is tasked to compile and maintain macroeconomic accounts and indicators at the national and sub-national levels;

WHEREAS, the PSA, through the Macroeconomic Accounts Service, regularly releases the annual and quarterly national accounts, annual regional accounts, and other economic accounts;

WHEREAS, there is a need to characterize data at the sub-regional level to better assess the performance of the regional as well as provincial economies in aid of socioeconomic development planning;

WHEREAS, the Philippine Statistical Development Program (PSDP) 2018-2023 under the Macroeconomic Accounts and Statistics chapter indicates the need to generate data on subnational accounts compiling the provincial product accounts (PPA);

WHEREAS, it is imperative that the Philippine Statistical System (PSS) institutionalizes the provision of data support for the compilation of PPA to enable to generate data on sub-national accounts,

WHEREAS, the PPA aims to provide a comprehensive assessment of the city and provincial economies:

WHEREAS, the PSA started the compilation of the PPA in 2021 in MIMAROPA, Central Visayas, and Northern Mindanao regions;

WHEREAS, the PSA Region 1 will consequently compile the PPA to enable more substantive assessment of the economic performance of the provinces and cities in Region 1;

WHEREAS, the administrative and survey data generated by the regional line agencies (RLAs), local government units (LGUs) and the private establishments could serve as inputs to the compilation of 2022 PPA of Region 1;

WHEREAS, there is need to conduct capability building activities to enable the RLAs, LGUs and the private sector to efficiently and accurately gather the needed data for the compilation of PPA;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED, to enjoin RLAs, LGUs, and the Private Sector in Region 1 to support and provide data needed for the compilation of the 2022 PPA of the provinces of Region 1;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the PSA shall:

- Undertake capacity-building activities to help the provinces and other agencies generate and compile the data requirements based on PSA concepts and standards;
- 2. Develop a roadmap towards the institutionalization of the data generation for PPA; and
- Formulate a communication plan and advocacy programs to facilitate the regular provision of data for the PPA.

RESOLVED FINALLY, to provide copies of this resolution to all RLAs, LGUs and the private sector for information and guidance;
