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PSA – Ilocos Sur Conducts 2022 Community – Based Monitoring System Data Turnover Ceremony in Santa Maria, Ilocos Sur

De Guzman, the Regional Director of the PSA Regional Statistical Services Office I who warmly welcomed participants and audiences to the event. Ms. Jeanette M. Marzan, the Chief Statistical Specialist of PSA - Ilocos Sur, then presented the key highlights of the 2022 CBMS results in Santa Maria.

Municipal Administrator eagerly welcomed the long-awaited availability of their data expressing heartfelt appreciation to the PSA for providing essential information to address constituents' needs, marking a significant milestone for the LGU. He emphasized that the data will serve as a driving force for the LGU to come up with sustainable programs and projects of the LGU.
