PSA-Ilocos Sur Joins 2024 National Women's Month Celebration

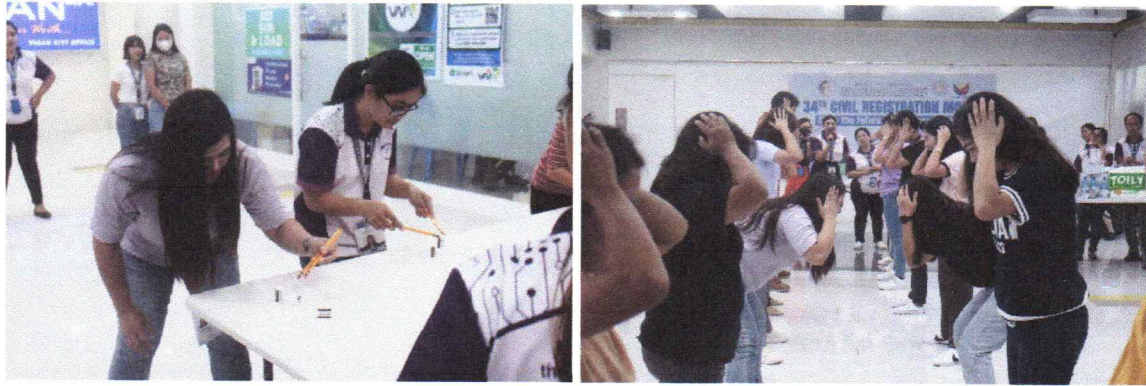
