## HIGHLIGHTS ON GARLIC PRODUCTION ILOCOS REGION, 2022

Date of Release: 23 June 2023 Reference No. 2023 - 037

In 2022, the production of garlic in llocos Region was recorded at 4,502.58 metric tons. Ilocos Region was the topmost producer among the six garlic producing regions in 2022 sharing 76.51 percent of the county's output of 5,884.93 metric tons.




Figure 1. Distribution of Garlic Production by Region Philippines, 2022 (in metric tons)

The region's garlic output of 4,502.58 metric tons slightly decreased by 1.50 percent. Said output were from Ilocos Norte and Ilocos Sur with drop of production of about 1.15 percent and 12.31 percent, respectively.



The harvest period of garlic in 2022 was first quarter. There was no production recorded from second to fourth quarter of 2022.




Figure 3. Garlic Production, by Quarter, Ilocos Region 2021 and 2022 (in metric tons)

## **TECHNICAL NOTES**

The Crops Production Survey (CrPS) is the source of production data of all crops, except palay and corn. Around 280 crops are covered in this survey. Garlic is among the major crops in llocos Region.

Estimates of production are generated from the CrPS, which is conducted quarterly. The CrPS covers all regions, except the National Capital Region.

## **Concept and Definition**

• Crop production refers to the quantity produced and harvested for a particular crop during the reference period. It includes those measured but damaged, stolen, given away, consumed, given as harvester's share, reserved, etc. It excludes those produced but not harvested due to low price, lack of demand, force majeure, or fortuitous events, etc.
