

Bauang is a 1st class municipality in the province of La Union, Philippines. Bauang was established as a settlement in 1590 with fray Agustin Mino as its first minister. As part of the province of Pangasinan, it was officially recognized as a town in 1765 with Don Francisco delos Reyes as its first gobernadorcillo. When La Union was created in 1850, Bauang was one of the twelve towns that formed the province. Bauang is also famous for its delicious grapes and guapples grown in barangays Payocpoc, Santiago, Bagbag and Urayong.

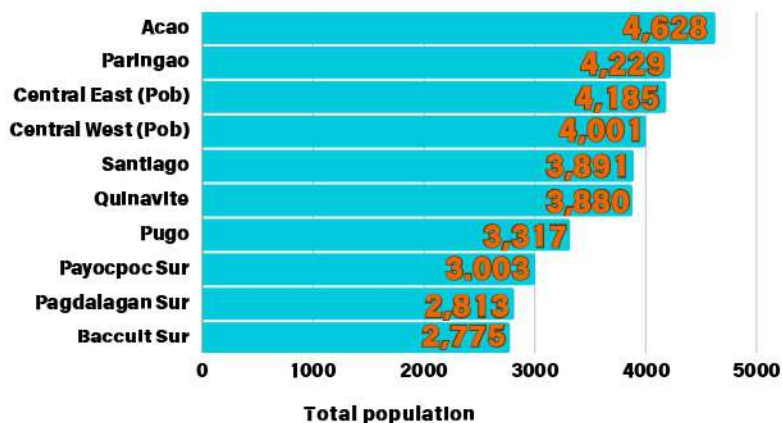

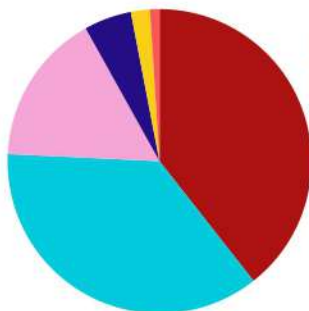
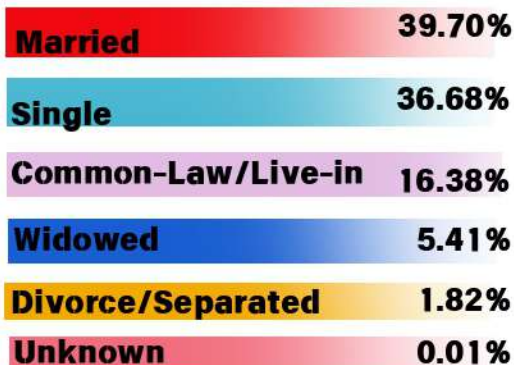
The annual average growth rate of the municipality's population during the period 2015-2020
