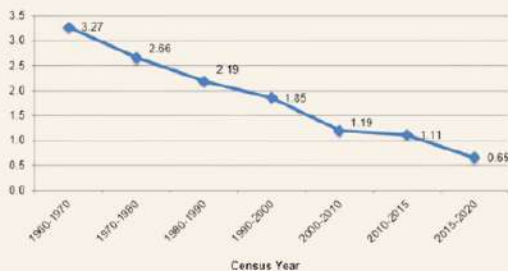

Top 10 Most Populous Barangays San Fernando, La Union: 2020

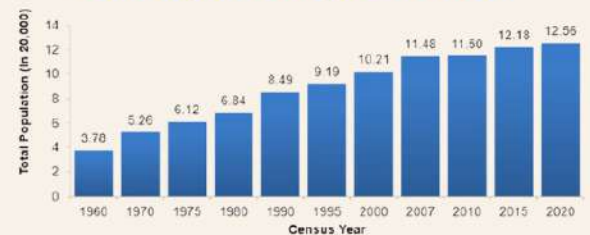


Population Growth Rate
