
Consumer Price Index (CPI)

is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by an average Filipino household. It shows how much the prices of goods and services have increased or decreased from a particular reference period known as base year.

Inflation Rate

refers to the annual rate of change or the year-on-year change of the CPI expressed in percent.

Main Contributors to the Overall Inflation Inflation Rate for Percent Share December 2024 Housing, Water, 10.9% Electricity, Gas and Other Fuels 1.5% Food and Non-alcoholic 26.5% Beverages Restaurants and 0.9% 3.8% Accommodation Services





Food inflation for the bottom 30% households at the provincial level exhibited a downtrend at 1.5 percent in December 2024 from 3.9 percent in November 2024. In December 2023, food inflation was observed at 12.5 percent.
