

Purchasing Power of Peso



The Purchasing Power of the Peso stood at 0.82 in August 2023. This means the purchasing 1.00 peso capability of decreased 18 centavos.

Technical Notes:

Consumer Price Index (CPI)
-is an indicator of the change in the average retail prices of a fixed basket of goods and services commonly purchased by households relative to a base year.

REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES

PHILIPPINES STATISTICS AUTHORITY

Purchasing Power of the Peso (PPP) - shows how much the peso in the base period is worth in the current period. It is computed as the reciprocal of the CPI for the period under review multiplied by 100.

Headline Inflation (HI) -is the rate of change in the weighted average prices of all goods and services in the CPI.

Inflation Rate (IR) -is the annual rate of change or the year-on-year
